It was recognized that in the city of Chicago there are many libraries, museums, colleges, and other institutions of learning founded for the use of the people, which might considerably enlarge the utility of their public service. To develop these opportunities a central board was established, known as The Council for Library and Museum Extension. The work of the Council is outlined along two lines: publicity and co-ordination. A centrally directed campaign of publicity has been planned to arouse the interest of the public in the educational opportunities freely offered at its very doors.
