Nux is stimulant, while Strychnine is sharply shocking. Nux causes general excitement, excites the motor tract of the cord, and increases receptive activity of the sensory tract; it is a direct stimulant to the heart muscle, also a powerful excitant to the respiratory center; it especially stimulates the Pneumogastric nerve. While it has no direct effect on the bodily temperature, it will warm up...
