He is the author of several medical essays, and has in manuscript a Dictionary of Aristophanes. - His nephew, Henry Cabot, author, b. in Boston, Mass., 12 May, 1850, was graduated at Harvard in 1871, and at the law-school in 1874, and in 1875 was given the degree of Ph. D. for his thesis on the Land Law of Anglo-Saxons (Boston, 1877). He was university lecturer on American history in 1876- 9, edited the North American Review in 1873- 6, and the International Review in 1879- 81, and served two terms in the Massachusetts legislature in...
